

As of 2021 Norway had 8.1 bln barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 2008.5 thousand barrels of crude oil per day, 54.5 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 3.9 Tcf of natural gas and 2.0 million tonnes of coal, extracted about 75.7 thousand short tons. Norway's conventional oil infrastructure include 2 operating oil refineries with a total crude oil processing capacity of 346 000 bpd; some FPSO terminals, oil terminals and oil storages. There are 1304 km of oil-/condensate pipeline. Conventional natural gas – include one large and four small operating LNG export terminals with a total import capacity of 4.6 million tonnes per year; two small operating LNG import terminals; some gas processing plants; 8520 km of natural gas pipeline.
